

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation that application for mining lease submitted by Carrol Wells to mine iron ore on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is hereby approved subject to applicable regulations pertaining to mining on Indian lands.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 2, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
