

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, on the grazing permit of Mr. Bert Coulter was approved on Contract I-30-Ind-2611 covering Range No. 13A which Permit is for the period from May 1, 1951 to April 30, 1954 and,

WHEREAS, by mutual agreement of Mr. Coulter and the council, arrangements have been made to cancel this permit, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the above described permit be cancelled effective November 1, 1952 under the following conditions:

1. No refund of unearned lease fees be made and
2. That Mr. Coulter's improvements be purchased from him in accordance with mutual agreement already reached by negotiation.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 3, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
