

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Lee Chartrand of Lakeside, Arizona has applied to the Council for a lease on certain Asbestos Mining property located immediately west of Canyon Creek and immediately south of the Oak Creek-Rock House road and comprising approximately 175 acres of tribal land, and

WHEREAS, the Office of Indian Affairs has advised that it will require advertisement in the leasing of tribal lands, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the Secretary of the Interior is hereby respectfully requested to cause the above property to be advertised for lease, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the chairman is hereby authorized to execute the lease.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 6, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
