WHEREAS, said Ordinance, being subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior, was on November 3, 1952 rescinded by him for reasons set forth in his letter of even date, and,

WHEREAS, it is still the desire of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to have in effect an Ordinance governing the activities of peddlers, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Ordinance No. 20 as corrected and amended be re-enacted subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (0) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1939, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
