WHEREAS, it has become apparent to the Tribal Council that the original estimates for the needs of the Tribe as contained in the Tribal Budget numbered TR 52-19 are inadequate to finish out the fiscal year, now

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the following itemized additions to the Tribal Budget (TR 52-19) are hereby authorized, in the amount of \$34,850.00, to be transferred from funds on deposit in the Treasury of the United States to the Tribal Disbursing Account.
