


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Silas O. Davis has a long record of service to the people of this reservation, especially in the field of guidance and assistance in the development of the recreation resources of the tribe, to which he has devoted generously of his time and talents without additional recompense, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the said Silas O. Davis, in appreciation, is hereby granted a lifetime free privilege of hunting and fishing on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation under the same regulations governing the use of these privileges by members of the tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 18, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 1 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (p) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
