

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on April 6, 1953, the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe adopted Resolution No. 53-11 requesting advertisement of certain reservation lands for lease for mining purposes, and,

WHEREAS, it was not stated in the resolution what mineral was to be mined, or the length of time the lease should run, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that resolution 53-11 be amended to specify the proposed lease for mining of iron ore, the term of said lease to be for ten (10) years.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 1, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
