

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is urgent need for the development of adequate water and sewage systems for the Whiteriver Community for the protection and convenience of the members of the tribe residing therein, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) is hereby authorized for expenditure from tribal funds on deposit in the Individual Indian Money Accounts of the Fort Apache Agency for the purpose of making a survey and developing plans for construction of these systems.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 6, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
