

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the Telephone Switchboard be operated from local I. I. M. funds in accordance with an agreement executed with the U. S. Government. Mr. Nelson Lupe, Sr., is authorized to sign the contract for the tribe. Three thousand three hundred dollars (\$3,300.) is hereby appropriated from local funds on deposit in the I. I. A. accounts at Fort Apache Agency to fulfill the terms of the contract from August 1, 1953 to June 30, 1954.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 15, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
