

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 53-3 dated February 9, 1953 approved the advertisement and sale of timber in the Long Tom Canyon Logging Unit,

AND WHEREAS, Resolution 53-3 inadvertently omitted the statement: "the Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized to sign the contract covering the sale of said timber",

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this council hereby verifies the action of the Chairman and Secretary when on June 23, 1953 they signed the Long Tom Canyon Logging Unit contract.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 15, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
