

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, application has been made by J. H. Webb, Lakeside, Arizona for a parcel of isolated timber in Long Tom Canyon, near Highway 60 containing approximately 150,000 board feet removeable,

AND WHEREAS, the Forestry Branch recommends this area to be logged after selective marking,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the above mentioned timber be advertised according to regulations for not less than \$11.00 per M.B.F. and that thirty dollars (\$30.00) be made available for newspaper advertisement.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 9, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
