

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the duties of the Tribal Council Secretary have increased, particularly since she is now handling the relief work for the Tribe, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that effective July 12, 1953 the position of Secretary to the council be compensated at the same rate as a Civil Service position in G.S.-5, with the same have privileges and periodic promotions as for the Civil Service position.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 15, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
