

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Monez, of the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., appeared before the White Mountain Apache Council at the regular September meeting on September 8, 1953 and requested a lease on the Iron Mine west of Cibecous in T.9 R 15 1/2 E. on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation the exact location and size to be shown on the final survey, and

WHEREAS, the royalties offered will be ten per cent (10%) of the value of the ore at the shipping point which will be at the mine.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the lease for the mining of Iron by the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., is approved without advertising on the basis of royalties offered. Mr. Nelson Lupe, Sr., Chairman of the Tribal Council is authorized to sign the lease for the tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 8, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
