

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there will be continuing need for educational facilities on this reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Whiteriver Public School Board has applied for a lease on a tract of tribal land at Whiteriver for a high school location, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council hereby consents and agrees that the Whiteriver Public School Board, pursuant to applicable Public Laws, may erect or cause to be erected, upon the hereinafter described premises, a school and school facilities, and may operate and maintain such facilities on said premises

The premises referred to above may be more particularly referred to as a tract of tribal land 10.38 acres in area, designated as "Tract B" on the attached map, located south of and immediately adjacent to the tract previously set aside for educational purposes by Council Resolution No. 52-28 dated August 16, 1952, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby also consents and agrees to furnish water, electric, sewage and other utilities or services, if available, for the facilities. PROVIDED that the cost thereof shall be reimbursed to the White Mountain Apache Tribe in accordance with existing laws and regulations governing such reimbursements. If such utilities or services are unavailable or inadequate, the Whiteriver Public School Board may obtain them from other sources, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby grants to the Whiteriver Public School Board or its designee all necessary rights of ingress and egress over the reservation for the purpose of constructing and operating the school facilities and,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized to enter into and sign on behalf of the Tribe a lease consistent with this resolution and with the Constitution of the Tribe or that the Superintendent of the Agency is authorized to issue a revocable permit to the Whiteriver Public School Board consistent therewith.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 2, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
