

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to encourage members of the tribe to improve their standard of living, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.) is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the S.D.A. Accounts of the Fort Apache Agency for the purpose of extending water main lines in the Whiteriver Community.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 3, 1954 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
