

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a revised memorandum of Agreement between the Arizona Game and Fish Commission, the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Fish and Wildlife Service for the continued operation of the Federal Fish Hatchery has been presented to the Council for consideration, and

WHEREAS, the revised agreement meets with the approval of this council, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that said memorandum of agreement is hereby approved and the Chairman is authorized to sign the agreement on behalf of the tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 3, 1954 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1933 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1933 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
