

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is increasing need for an adequate aerial map of the Fort Apache Reservation for use in technical program involving utilization of tribal resources, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council to obtain this map as expeditiously and as economically as possible, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that an endeavor be made to include the aerial mapping of the Fort Apache Reservation in the contract now under consideration for mapping the San Carlos reservation, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of thirty-seven thousand dollars (\$37,000.) is hereby appropriated from funds on deposit in the S.D.A. Accounts of the Fort Apache Agency for this purpose.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 4, 1954 and duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
