

RESOLUTION
of The
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Arizona, is a recognized Indian tribe organized under a constitution and by-laws ratified by the tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior August 26, 1938, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended by the Act of June 15, 1935 (49 Stat. 373); and

WHEREAS, under Article VI, sec. 1 (d) of the constitution and by-laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the tribal council is empowered to expend local tribal funds with expenditures in excess of \$1,000 requiring Secretarial approval; and

WHEREAS, over a period of years reimbursable loans were made to members of the tribe for various purposes, with tribal industrial assistance funds used for such loans; and

WHEREAS, it is now evident that the outstanding balance involved in the reimbursable loans represents the drags of the reimbursable loan program and that the amounts due from individuals are uncollectible; and further in view of the fact that the reimbursable program is in a process of liquidation; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the tribal council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that payment is authorized to be made from local tribal funds now on deposit to the credit of the tribe in the Indian Money accounts of the Fort Apache Agency, if the reimbursable agreements listed on the attached sheet and in the amounts as shown; and be it further

RESOLVED, that in the event of any future recoveries of the listed amounts paid by the tribe from its local tribal funds, that such amounts recovered shall be deposited to the credit of the tribe in the Indian Money accounts at Fort Apache Agency.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, hereby certify that the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is composed of 9 members, of whom 9, constituting a quorum, were present at a meeting thereof, duly and regularly called, noticed, convened, and held this 4th day of May, 1954; that the fore-

going resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by an affirmative vote of 9 members; and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
