

RESOLUTION OF THE  
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has certain employment for whom it must as a matter of necessity provide living quarters, and

WHEREAS, the Council has need for a building providing office space for its employees, storage space for tribal equipment and supplies and shop space for necessary tribal enterprises,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of \$30,000 be and is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the SDA accounts of the Fort Apache Agency for the following:

1. Construction of one three-bedroom and one two-bedroom cottage \$20,000.00
2. Construction of a building for office, warehouse and shop purposes 10,000.00

The foregoing Resolution was on August 3, 1954 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
