

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council has approved the employment of a full-time manager for its recreation enterprise and is contemplating the establishment of a tribal position of social worker, and

WHEREAS, there will be continuing need for housing for tribal employees and for shop storage and office space for tribal work, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the S.D.A. Accounts of the Fort Apache Agency for the following purposes:

1. Construction of one two-bedroom cottage and one three-bedroom cottage including purchase of equipment \$20,000.
2. Construction of a building for shop, storage and office space including purchase of equipment \$10,000.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 4, 1954 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
