

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc. of McNary, Arizona is contractor of the Maverick Logging Unit and,

WHEREAS, a modification in this contract expires March 31, 1954, and a new modification is necessary as follows:

The purchaser shall cut not to exceed 18 million board feet during any 12-month period ending March 31, except that he may cut not to exceed 35 million board feet during the year ending March 31, 1954 and not to exceed 22 million feet during each of the years ending March 31, 1955 to March 31, 1959, both inclusive; Provided, that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs may authorize the purchaser to exceed the maximum allowable cut in any such 12-month period; Provided further, that in no event shall the total cut exceed 300 million board feet for the 15-year period ending March 31, 1959, or 100 million board feet, for each of the 5-year periods ending March 31, 1964 and 1969.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 1st day of March, 1954 that the said modification of contract covering the Maverick Logging Unit be approved and that the Chairman and Secretary of the Council be authorized to sign the modification papers.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 1, 1954 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
