

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. G. L. Noel has requested permission to assign his manganese lease Contract 14-20-452-4, to Mr. Al Stovall of Phoenix, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Stovall has requested an amendment to the lease to provide for deduction of milling and transportation costs of fifty-four dollars and fifty cents (\$54.50) per long ton from the gross receipts before figuring royalties, and

WHEREAS, the Council is satisfied with the above proposals, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that assignment of lease by Mr. Noel to Mr. Stovall and the amendment concerning the figuring of royalties is hereby approved.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 2, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
