

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on December 7, 1954, the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe adopted Resolution No. 54-31, covering budget of estimated expenditures for the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise for the period from January 1, 1955 to December 31, 1955, and

WHEREAS, certain savings have been effected due to lapses in salaries and equipment purchases, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the following changes in the budget be hereby authorized:
