

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is need to replace three automotive units being used by the tribal police, and

WHEREAS, there is need for transportation for the tribal construction and maintenance supervisor, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session that the sum of seven thousand dollars (\$7,000.00) is hereby authorized and appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the I.I.W. Accounts of the Fort Apache Agency for the purchase of three one-half ton pickup trucks, including trade-in and one, one-half ton panel delivery automobile, without trade-in.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 6, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
