

RESOLUTION OF THE  
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is need for the services of a qualified Social Worker for the benefit of the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it is hereby requested that a position of Social Worker, GS-2, be established payable from tribal funds on deposit in the Treasury of the United States, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that item (b) in Section IV the tribal budget for fiscal year 1956 be hereby rescinded.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 6, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 7 For and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1933 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE

WHEREAS, the business of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has increased to the point where additional office space is needed,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) be hereby appropriated for the constructing and equipping of an office building at Whiteriver, said building to house the tribal council offices and employment services.

The foregoing Resolution was on August 1, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
