

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, THE White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise under a plan of operation approved November 24, 1954 and accepted by the Tribe on December 7, 1954, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient that the operations of the recreation enterprise be placed into effect with as little delay as possible, now be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe the "Management Contract for the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise" between Silas O. Davis and the White Mountain Apache Tribe executed under date of JAN 10, 1955 and attached hereto, and by reference made a part of this resolution as if set out in full herein; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Interior or his authorized representative is hereby requested to expedite final action on the attached management contract

The foregoing Resolution was on January 4, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 2 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
