

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on December 14, 1954, bids were opened for the sale of a mining lease on claims 1 through 10 of the Apache Extension, and

WHEREAS, no lease was made as a result of this advertisement, there being only one bidder, who subsequently defaulted, and

WHEREAS, Atomic Ore, Incorporated of Globe, Arizona has now applied for an asbestos mining lease on this property, therefore

IT IS RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a lease be negotiated on this property with Atomic Ore, Incorporated.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is hereby authorized to sign the lease on behalf of the tribe.

This resolution rescinds Tribal Resolution No. 55-13 adopted May 2, 1955.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 1, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
