

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the duties of the Chairman of the Council have increased to the point where his salary is no longer commensurate therewith, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the salary of the Chairman be increased to four thousand eight hundred dollars (\$4800) per year effective January 4, 1955.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 4, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
