

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there are at present four members of the tribe employed steadily at the McNary Fish Hatchery and jobs are available for two more, and

WHEREAS, no quarters are available for these people, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of thirty-six thousand dollars (\$36,000) is hereby authorized for expenditure from funds on deposit in the Individual Indian Money Accounts of the Fort Apache Agency for the construction of six cottages to be located near the Hatchery; said cottages to be rented to members of the tribe who are or may be employed at the Hatchery, at rates to be approved by the council.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 4, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
