

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Forestdale Unit Timber Contract No. I-30-ind-2522 was approved October 30, 1947 by the Commissioner will expire March 31, 1955 and,

HEREAS, there still remains on this unit approximately 15 million board feet of timber within the boundaries of this unit that require harvesting,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 7th day of March 1955 that the Forestdale Unit Timber Contract be extended for such time as is necessary to remove said timber provided a study be made to determine the proper stumpage price to be paid by the contractor.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 7, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
