

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it has become apparent that funds provided by Tribal Resolution No. 54-18 for FY 1954-55 are insufficient in certain instances to finish the fiscal year,

AND WHEREAS, the Council desires to furnish the additional amounts needed as follows:

Regular Council Meeting Expense - - - - -	\$ 400.00
Special Council Meeting Expense - - - - -	200.00
Committee Meeting Expense - - - - -	300.00
Council Travel Expense - - - - -	1100.00
Council Miscellaneous Expense - - - - -	375.00
Office Irregular Labor - - - - -	150.00
Court, Jail, Police Expense - - - - -	5000.00
Fairgrounds Operation & Maintenance - - - - -	700.00
Useless Horse Elimination - - - - -	150.00

NOW BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of eight thousand three hundred and seventy-five dollars and no cents is hereby authorized for expenditure from funds on deposit in the Individual Money Accounts of the Fort Apache Indian Agency according to the above listed schedule.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 4, 1955 duly accepted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
