

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on November 2, 1953 the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe adopted Resolution No. 53-44, setting aside a tract of tribal land at Whiteriver, Arizona, containing 10.38 acres as a site for the Whiteriver Public High School, and authorizing the Chairman of the Council to sign a lease or the Superintendent to issue a revocable permit covering same, and

WHEREAS, the Council has received informal advice that a small addition to this tract is needed as a site for teachers' quarters, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to negotiate with the Alchesay High School Board for the desired addition and to include same in the lease authorized under Resolution No. 53-44.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 3, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 2 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
