

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, White Mountain Apache Tribe, is authorized by its Constitution and By-Laws, approved August 26, 1938, to manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe, Article VI, Section 1 (n),

AND WHEREAS, the position of General Livestock Manager was proposed and approved by Resolution No. 56-1 of the Tribal Council, White Mountain Apache Tribe, on January 23, 1956,

AND WHEREAS, the members of the Tribal Council full recognize the importance of filling this position with a person who has demonstrated his abilities in range and livestock management.

AND WHEREAS, Marion D. Linn is considered fully qualified and having a thorough knowledge of livestock and range conditions in this area.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that we, the Tribal Council for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, recommend that this position be filled on February 1, 1956 and that Marion D. Linn is hereby recommended to fill that position.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 23, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
