

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, White Mountain Apache Tribe, is authorized by its Constitution and By-Laws, approved August 28, 1938, to manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe, Article VI, Section 1 (n),

AND WHEREAS, the Tribal (I.D.) Ranch is a Tribal livestock enterprise,


AND WHEREAS it is the policy of the Tribal Council to fill vacant positions with qualified members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,

AND WHEREAS the Tribal Council believes that Clinton Kessay is well experienced and qualified to serve as Manager of the Tribal (I.D.) Ranch.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Clinton Kessay is hereby recommended to fill the vacant position of Manager, Tribal (I.D.) Ranch which will become vacant February 1, 1956.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the position of Manager, Tribal (I.D.) Ranch shall be equivalent grade of CPC-7 (old scale) and be subject to leave and salary increases equivalent to a government employee of like grade.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 26, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
