

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, White Mountain Apache Tribe is authorized by its Constitution and By-Laws, approved August 26, 1938, to manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe, Article VI, Section 1 (n)

AND WHEREAS, the Tribal (E.D.) Ranch is a Tribal owned enterprise

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the position of Foreman, Tribal Ranch be established on an equivalent basis as livestock association stockmen. As follows:

- (1) CPC-5 (U.S. Government old scale) \$2974.00 per annum
- (2) Annual pay increases at \$80.00 per annum
- (3) Authorized 14 work days per annum leave

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the position of Foreman, I.D. Ranch is under the general supervision of the General Livestock Manager and the direct supervision of the I.D. Ranch manager.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 26, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
