

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Frost Geophysical Corporation of Albuquerque, New Mexico holds prospecting permits for Uranium Units Nos. 2 and 3 as authorized by Tribal Resolution 55-23 of August 15, 1955 and Contract 14-20-452-21 and 14-20-452-25.

WHEREAS, this company has applied for a mining lease on asbestos fiber which might be discovered in explorations made for uranium, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council that all possible revenue accrue to the Tribe through development of its mining possibilities, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session that a mining lease on asbestos, in accordance with regulations governing such leases, be negotiated with the Frost Geophysical Corporation. The Chairman and Secretary of the Council are hereby authorized to sign said lease on behalf of the Council.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 6, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
