

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, in building known as the "Creamery" which is adjacent to the Dairy Barn at Whiteriver, Arizona is in use as emergency quarters by a tribal employee and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this building continue to be used as tribal quarters,

NOW BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) from local tribal funds be allotted for the repair of this building to make it more habitable.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 7, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
