

RESOLUTION OF THE  
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, an unforeseen incident has occurred, in which all the plaster of a kitchen ceiling in a tribally owned house has fallen,  
 AND WHEREAS, not enough funds to cover such events had been allowed for in the regular budget (TR 55-18) to effect the necessary repairs,  
 NOW BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.) be transferred to the tribal Disbursing Account from funds on deposit in local tribal accounts, to make the necessary repairs.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 8, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
