

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, under Section 6, Item (b) (1), Open and Closed Seasons, Bag Limits, etc., of ORDINANCE No. 14, Hunting and Fishing Code, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, the Tribal Council has authority to fix open seasons and bag limits for tribal members, and

WHEREAS, ORDINANCE No. 14 was amended by ORDINANCE No. 19 on May 5, 1952, and

WHEREAS, the bag limit on trout for tribal members has not been officially set by the Council since said amendment has been in effect,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the bag limit on trout for tribal members be hereby fixed at fifteen (15) trout in possession at any one time and that said fifteen (15) trout, legally caught from reservation waters, shall constitute one day's legal bag limit for members of the tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 22, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (p) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
