WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, we, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe realize the high aims and intentions of the members of the Canyon Day Community in organizing themselves together into the Canyon Day Community Development Association,

AND WHEREAS, it is the duty and desire of the Tribal Council to promote and assist in the progress and the social, moral and economic development of our members,

AND WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized in the Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Article VI, Section 1, Paragraph (j) as approved August 26, 1938 to charter subordinate organizations for economic purposes and to regulate the activities of all cooperative associations of members of the Tribe.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Constitution and By-Laws of the Canyon Day Community Development Association as submitted and approved by resolution of its members be hereby approved.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 5, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (J) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
