

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is authorized by its Constitution and By-Laws as approved August 26, 1938, Article VI, Powers of the Tribal Council, Section 1, Paragraph (n) to "manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe, in accordance with the terms of said Constitution and By-Laws".

AND WHEREAS, the Tribal (ID) Ranch is a tribal owned livestock enterprise operated for the purpose of improving the quality of cattle on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Stanley Wright is hereby employed as Ranch Manager with an equivalent position and pay as a CPC 7, Government Personnel Classification Act of 1949 as amended October 24, 1951, PL 65, Statute 612.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution will rescind Resolution No. 56-3, passed January 26, 1956.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 5, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
