

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, this council has made one hundred six thousand, six hundred dollars (\$106,600) available for new aerial photographs of all the reservation and to inventory the virgin and cut-over forest lands,

AND WHEREAS, on May 21, 1956 three bids were received, and the lowest of ninety-four thousand, five hundred sixty dollars (\$94,560) was made by Hammon, Jensen and Wallen of Oakland, California,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by this Council that a contract be made with the above mentioned firm and that the Chairman and Secretary of this Council be authorized to approve said contract.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 5, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
