

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, White Mountain Apache Tribe, is authorized by its Constitution and By-Laws as approved August 26, 1938, Article VI, Section 1, Paragraph (j) " to charter subordinate organizations for economic purposes and to regulate the activities of all cooperative associations of members of the Tribe".

AND WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, White Mountain Apache Tribe, on July 14, 1950 approved the Constitution and By-Laws of the following livestock associations:

Carrizo, Canyon Day, Cibecue, Cedar Creek, Grasshopper, North Fork, Oak Creek and Turkey Creek,

AND WHEREAS, certain amendments have been found necessary by the members of said livestock associations, approved by resolutions at general meetings of each livestock association and properly signed by the respective association officers,

BUT IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that such amendments as read by the Tribal Chairman pertaining to

- (1) Liability of members
- (2) Increase in rates of per diem for certain association directors
- (3) Changes in budget years of associations

be hereby approved.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 5, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (j) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
