

RESOLUTION OF THE  
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Frost Geophysical Corporation of Albuquerque, New Mexico is presently engaged in prospecting for asbestos within the confines of the areas designated as Units Nos. 2 and 3 and

WHEREAS, the said Frost Geophysical Corporation has not as yet been able to establish definitely the limits of promising areas in which to apply for and develop mining leases on asbestos fiber as authorized by Tribal Resolution 56-8 dated February 6, 1956.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session that permission be granted to the Frost Geophysical Corporation to continue their asbestos explorations until December 31, 1956.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 15, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
