

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has been cooperating with the United States Department of the Interior, Fish and Wildlife Service in a program for control of predatory animals and rodent pests on the Fort Apache Reservation for several years, and

WHEREAS, Russell C. Culbreath, the Mammal-Control Agent presently assigned to the Fort Apache Reservation is serving in the position of Senior Mammal-Control Agent, \$3,440.00 per annum but performing all the duties that qualify him for the position Principal Mammal-Control Agent, \$3,670.00 per annum,

WHEREAS, Russell C. Culbreath is serving in the capacity of a District Supervisor and his work in predatory animal control for the past several years has been outstanding,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that we recommend and approve a promotion from Senior Mammal-Control Agent at a salary of \$3,670.00 per annum and effective date of increase shall be July 1, 1956.

The foregoing resolution was on July 17, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
