

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to encourage and materially assist Arizona Inter-Tribal Council in its endeavors to have a brief filed with the presiding referee in the Arizona vs California hearing,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty dollars (\$250.00) of Tribal Funds now on deposit in an Individual Money Account at the Fort Apache Indian Agency is hereby appropriated and authorized to be paid to Clarence Wesley of San Carlos, Arizona, Chairman of the Arizona Inter-Tribal Council. Said sum to be used for the payment of expenses incurred in the filing of above mentioned brief.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1933 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
