


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Firebox Spruce-Fir Logging Unit No. 1 be surveyed, appraised and made available for logging and milling by the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company, a tribal enterprise, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that proper forestry practices be applied to this unit, and that the Chairman of this Council or his proper representative be authorized to sign a contract for the logging and milling of said timber in such quantity as the Manager of the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company may require.

The foregoing Resolution was on August 8, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 904).
