

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution No. 56-13 appropriating funds for the 1957 Fiscal Year Tribal Budget, was adopted May 7, 1956 and approved July 13, 1956, and

WHEREAS, said tribal budget failed to provide funds in Section X for the employment of a qualified maintenance Foreman and did not provide sufficient funds for the purchase of a suitable vehicle,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Fiscal Year 1956 Tribal Budget is hereby amended, and funds are hereby appropriated, to provide an additional six thousand six hundred dollars (\$6,600.00) in Section X for the following purposes:

Salary of Maintenance Foreman at \$2.25 per hour - - \$4,800.

Additional amount for purchase of 1½ Ton Truck - - 1,800.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that this resolution recinds Tribal Resolution No. 56-47, passed September 10, 1956.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 24, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
