

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company, a tribal enterprise, has found spruce and fir timber from Firebox Spruce-Fir Logging Unit No. 1 to be satisfactory, and that additional timber of this kind is needed,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a survey be made to locate additional spruce and fir timber for appraisal to be utilized by the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company, and that the Chairman of this Council be authorized to sign a contract for the logging and milling of said timber in such quantity as the manager of the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company may require.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
