


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there are innumerable members of the Tribal Council working in diversified tribal enterprises, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for a personnel management program to be adopted;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a certain document, three copies of which are on file in the Tribal Office of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, being marked and designated as "Management Program for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Organization" be, and the same is hereby adopted as the personnel management program of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and be it further resolved that said document be made a public record.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 19, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
